



DEAD AND DYING TREE REMOVAL PROGRAM

Who We Are-

The Butte County Fire Safe Council is a 501(c)(3) non-profit that has been serving Butte County for over 20 years. Traditionally, we have focused on wildfire prevention, safety, and education. Since the 2018 Camp Fire, we have broadened our scope to include fire recovery.

Our Project-

Our Tree Removal Project is focused on removing merchantable dead and dying trees over 12" in diameter that could inhibit new construction. Due to limited funding, we can only help certain landowners who meet specific qualifications within the footprint.

To Qualify, Landowners Must -

- Have pulled a building permit on the property where tree removal will be conducted.
- The property must be within the Camp Fire footprint.
- 70% of the dead and dying trees to be removed from the property must be conifers. Harvestable trees (Cedar, Pine, Fir) are necessary to offset the high costs of tree removal.
- Have at least 20 harvestable trees between the property with a building permit and those directly adjacent.
- Be paying for reconstruction themselves.
- Own property directly adjacent to properties with building permits pulled.
 - Assistance from landowners receiving this flyer with contacting landowners directly adjacent for tree removal is appreciated.
